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INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPPER ENDOSCOPY (ESOPHAGOGASTRODUODENOSCOPY, EGD) w/ERCP

FOR THE BEST POSSIBLE EXAMINATION, PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW CAREFULLY.

- You must have a responsible adult (age 18 or older) to drive you home after your procedure. This does not include rideshare such as taxi, Uber. The sedative medication makes it unsafe to drive on the day of the procedure. If you do not have a chaperone to drive you home, the appointment may need to be cancelled.
- Plan to take the day off from work.
- **Do not** bring children to your appointment.
- Leave jewelry and valuable items at home.
- DO NOT eat ANY SOLID FOOD beginning <u>8 HOURS</u> before the procedure. If your procedure is in the morning, then avoid any such food after midnight the night before.
- It is **OK to** have clear liquids (Water, Gatorade etc.) **up to 2 hours** before your procedure.
- If you are on any blood thinners (Full dose ASA- 325mg, Coumadin, Plavix, Brillinta, Eliquis etc.), please let the office staff know and discuss with your endoscopist for further instructions.

DO NOT take your morning diabetic medication on the day of your procedure.

- **DO** take your heart/blood pressure medication with a few sips of water on the morning of your procedure.
- **Bring** all of your daily medications (or an updated list) to your procedure.

It takes approximately 20 - 30 minutes to perform your procedure.

After the examination, you will remain in the recovery area for 30 - 60 additional minutes for observation.
